VINYL

HOMETECH WINDOW CORPORATION, warrants against such defects that result in blistering, peeling and corroding of the window frames or sashes.

The Warranty on the Vinyl frame and sash shall remain in effect only if normal cleaning practices are followed. See "Maintenance".

HARDWARE

HOMETECH WINDOW CORPORATION, warrants that hardware shall remain in operational condition. This warranty applies to factory defects.

INSULATED GLASS UNITS

Seal failure of insulated glass unit including obstruction of vision and or film formation or dust collection between the glass is warranted. See "Warranty Limitations"

WARRANTY LIMITATIONS

HOMETECH WINDOW CORPORATION, is limited solely and exclusively to repair or replacement, at our discretion. HOMETECH WINDOW CORPORATION, will not be liable for any labour installation or freight costs.

EXCLUSION

- A. Any defects due to improper and unreasonable use or failure to perform necessary maintenance.
- B. Any damage due to settlement or structural defects.
- C. Any damage due to acts of God, hail, lightning, wind, etc.
- D. Intentional neglect, accidents or exposure to chemicals or pollutants.
- E. Damages caused by improper storage, handling, or installation.
- F. Broken glass or torn screens.
- G. Any modifications or repairs done by unauthorized representatives.
- H. Condensation not within the sealed unit but on the surface of the glass can be considered normal due to temperature changes and humidity levels within the home.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE OF YOUR WINDOW

Semi annual cleaning of windows is recommended. A mild household soap may be used. Caution: Do not use abrasive chemicals or materials in cleaning.

Light lubrication of all moving components is recommended semi annually. Following these simple procedures will guarantee you many years of pleasure.
